LCDR Carlson was born and raised in Wahpeton, North Dakota. He attended the U.S. Naval Academy where he completed his Bachelors Degree in Physics and earned his commission in 2008. In 2015 he completed his Masters Degree in National Security and Strategic Studies through the U.S. Naval War College.

LCDR Carlson completed his division officer tours serving in USS BOONE (FFG 28), USS FIREBOLT (PC 10) & USS SIROCCO (PC 6), and RIVERINE SQUADRON TWO. During these tours he deployed five times to the 4th, 6th, and 5th Fleet Areas of Responsibility. As a department head he served as the Operations, Weapons, and Combat Systems Officer in USS STETHEM (DDG 63) while forward deployed to Yokosuka Japan where he conducted numerous at-sea operations.
