Captain Pedro Arentsen Morales, was born in the city of Punta Arenas on May 20, 1970 and completed his basic and media studies at the German School in that city.

He entered the "Arturo Prat" Naval School in 1986 and graduated as Executive Officer in 1990. Subsequently (1991), he made the 36th Instruction Cruise aboard the School Ship BE-43 "Esmeralda".

He studied at the Naval Polytechnic Academy, obtaining a professional degree as a Naval Engineer in Armament mention in Electronic Warfare.

Currently, it has more than 16 years of embarkation in different afloat units, among them: School Ship BE-43 "Esmeralda", DDG.19 "Almirante Williams", Barge LST-95 "Chacabuco", Destroyer DLH-12 "Admiral Cochrane", Lancel Misilera LM-38" Lieutenant Serrano "as his Commander, Frigate FF-19" Admiral Williams", Frigate FF-07" Admiral Lynch "as Operations Officer and later as his Commander.

He has been Chief of the Guard since 2001.

He made a professional exchange in the Third Fleet of the Navy of the United States, on board the Destroyer DDG-63 "Stethem", in the year 2002.

It was part of the first crew of the Frigate FFG-07 "Almirante Lynch" in the Puente II Project, from the transfer from the United Kingdom to Chile, of the Fragatas type 23 to our country.

He holds a Master's Degree in Naval Sciences from the Naval War Academy of Chile and a Master's Degree in Naval Sciences from the Brazilian War Academy; He is also an Academy Professor in Naval Strategy.
